National Bank Contest: Rules and Regulations

1. Participation rules

Audiences targeted by AGAC and National Bank are invited to participate in the Contest by entering a draw. The Contest is organized by AGAC and is hosted on Papier's website: www.papiermontreal.com/en/national-bank-contest/

How to enter the National Bank Contest:

To participate, a person must:

- Complete and submit the online form.
- A maximum of one entry per person will be accepted for the duration of the Contest.

2. Eligibility

To enter the Contest, participants must be 18 years of age or older on the date of entry and reside in Canada. Proof of age and address may be requested from the winner upon selection.

Employees of AGAC, its representatives and the freelancers it employs, as well as exhibitors of the fair are not eligible to participate.

3. Contest duration

The Contest begins on November 15, 2021, and ends on December 15, 2021, at 11:59 pm (Eastern Time).

4. Prize to be won

The winner will receive an artwork by artist Nicolas Grenier, *No Horizon,* which is part of the AGAC 2020 Collection and valued at \$1,250.

5. Winner selection

The winner will be determined by a random drawn on December 20, 2021.
